Meet Our Juror: Jeanne Dunn



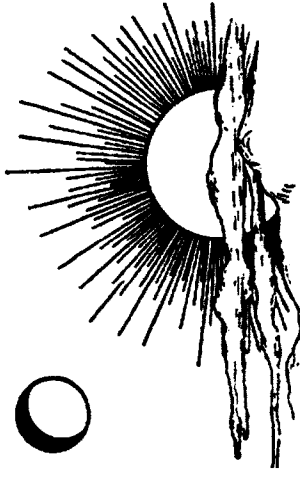
Jeanne Dunn is an artist and educator who has lived, worked, and exhibited in the San Diego area for years. She teaches Life Drawing, Painting, and Design in the School of Art, Design, and Art History at San Diego State University. This year she was accepted as a member of the Los Angeles Art Association /Gallery 825 in Los Angeles, a non-profit arts organization.

Dunn received her BS in Art and Art Education from the University of Wisconsin, Madison, and her MA in Painting from San Diego State University. She has won awards for her paintings and has exhibited in Los Angeles, New York, Cambridge (UK), Budapest, Istanbul, and at the Musée Rochefort, France. In the last two years she has been awarded an international artist residency at the Hungarian Cultural Center in Budapest and a fellowship to the Maryland Institute College of Art's Artist Residency Program at Rochefort-en-Terre, France. Her studio is in the North Park community of San Diego. Her current paintings explore ideas of path, direction, and one's internal compass, citing the natural landscape.
