### August Show Judge: Liane Kim

Born in South Korea, Liane Kim studied at Nam Young Fine Art College in Korea. After moving to the United States with her family, Liane continued to study at the Honolulu Academy Of Art where her work was exhibited along with other selected artists. In 1988, Liane was further honored by receiving a Gold Medal from the Seoul Olympic Committee for her artistic expressions.

The impressionistic tendency of Liane's work gives each piece a life of its own. The lucid elegance of watercolor and ink makes these mediums Liane's favorites.

Her accomplished technique of combining Oriental Art and Western materials represents a bridging of the East and West Cultures.

In Liane's most recent (Giclée), signed limited editions you can clearly see her love of European scenes where she graciously expresses the beauty and spiritual character of natural stone. Her award winning work is on display at East West Art & Frame, where Liane is proprietor and designer, and in galleries and private collections in San Diego and throughout the United States and Europe.

### Hint From the July Judge/ Demonstrator

Josie Gable Rodriguez makes color copies (Xerox works best) of her old work, photos, text and even fortune cookie messages to use in new projects. After coating with gel medium, she coats the image with acetone, lays image side down and burnishes the image to transfer it to her base.

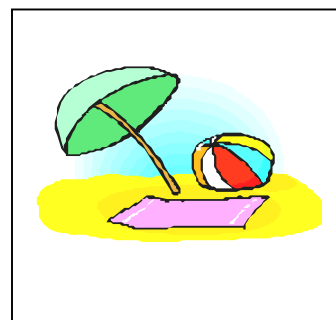

- Assist 4,000 abused children at the Polinsky Children's Center by providing them with emergency shelter, food, clothing, medical care, education, developmental screenings, and other support.
- Brighten the lives of 2,123 foster children through CAPF's Birthday Club, a program that provides gift certificates to abused children on their birthdays.
- Help deserving young adults achieve their educational goals, through the CAPF Foster Fund, our scholarship program for former foster youth.
- Educate parents about how to help their children safely use the Internet through the

Protecting children Online Safety Campaign.

CAPF also helps in many other ways to give these children a real chance at a normal life. Our \$1100 went to buy books for recovering students who were on high school scholarships. They do a great job and we are proud to be able to help.

We need someone with a van or station wagon to be on call for the general meetings to help us transport the demonstration mirror from storage to the Ecke building when any of our demonstrators might need it.

If you can help us with this job, please call Alessandra Colfi and let her know.

## SDAG Artists to be seen on Home and Garden TV!

On June 7th **Kim Treffinger** and **Alessandra Colfi** were individually taped in their studios for demonstrations of their artwork (Kim -fused glass, and Alessandra-greeting cards) for a new show on Home and Garden TV called "**Crafters Coast to Coast**" to air sometime in the fall.

The 30 minute show will have a whimsical lighthearted style to it, featuring 4 different artists from around the country in each episode. The director was Celia Bonaduce, sister of Danny Bonaduce (of the Partridge Family), and quite hilarious in her own right. Kim and Alessandra had a challenging but fun time and it was a long day for the crew, as they arrived at Kim's house at 7:45 am and did not leave for Alessandra's until 4pm! They worked with Alessandra until about 10 pm. The show will feature aspects of our personal lives as much as the art projects we demonstrated- and Kim's large collection of pets were hijacked and all featured as well. Alessandra was asked to don some outfits matching her cards created on the show: Wetsuit, hula skirt.... They definitely made us stretch beyond what we thought the show would be like.

Kim had been selling her glasswork at the Scripp's Ranch Farmer's Market last year and became friends with the manager after several of her best pieces blew off and smashed from the wind. The Manager Bev Cassity advertises her art fairs in major craft magazines, and the show casting director called her up looking for artists interested in doing this. Bev gave Kim their contact info and she sent her portfolio online. Literally within 15 min. she got a call back, and an interview. She was also asked if she knew of any other craft artists and was able to provide Alessandra's name, and she got the call from the show without any warning while in line at the Post Office! Needless to say, Alessandra and Kim have been very excited about this amazing opportunity. By the end of Sept. the air dates should be accessible on the HGTV website.

*Following is a complete list of rules for "take-in". Please save it and refer to it before submitting paintings for the monthly shows. Thanks, Joan Grine, Monthly Show Chair*

**RULES FOR MONTHLY TAKE-IN**

All work must be original work, not a reproduction, and must be for sale.

All work should be less than two years old, and cannot have been in a previous SDAG show.

Please have your entry slip already filled out, except for the Item Number, which will be added at the check-in table. There will be one of these slips printed in your Paint Rag. You only need one.

Your work should have some identification on the back.

If there is a question about the Department Number, there is a list on the take-in table, or a volunteer can help you. Your entry must be in the correct department or it may be ineligible for judging.

Do not bring in wet paintings or frames.

A 15% commission will be charged on sales from the Monthly Show.

Work must be framed unless you use the wrap-around canvas stapled in the back.

The wire should be the multi-strand wire, attached approximately one fourth of the way down from the top of the frame, and slack enough to come up to approximately 2" from the top of the frame.

Please tape the ends of the wire, and please don't put tape or tubing in the middle of the wire. It will not fit our hangers if you do.

If your work, including frame, measures less than 30" on the longest side, your fee is \$10. For work 30" and up to 38" (which is the maximum size that we can accept), the fee is \$20. *Measure carefully.*

Be sure your work looks as nice as it can, with clean, well put-together frame, clean glass and a well cut mat.

*The Take-in committee reserves the right to refuse entries that do not meet gallery standards.*

Lets all try to keep our take-in running smoothly and have our gallery look as good we can.
